- Provide legal counsel to children who have been removed by the Department of Child Services as a result of allegations of abuse or neglect under Indiana law
- Perform any other functions the Senior Judge and the Court Executive may deem necessary to carry out the duties of the Lake Superior Court Juvenile Justice Complex
