LCCEDD will be receiving an additional \$1,222,974.00 specifically to
“prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus” pandemic.

As part of the process to access these funds the public, the 16 partner
communities and the various social service agencies affiliated with LCCEDD are all
being asked to submit comments and/or requests for the uses of these funds.

The comments and requests need to be specific to the purpose of the funds
as stipulated in the law: “to prevent, prepare for and respond to the coronavirus”.

The below list of possible uses is not inclusive:

Medical Supplies such as gloves, masks, gowns, and other PPE supplies
since the declaration was made at the end of March; Transit related to
Coronavirus Patients; Disinfecting Facilities and Supplies; Hazard Pay; Homeless
Prevention; Medical Facilities (temporary and permanent); Coroner Facilities;
Small Business Loans/Grants; Equipment and Facilities to create “touchless”
interior environment; Remote learning equipment.
