The Court has ordered you on In-House Detention, Level One in lieu of detention at the Lake County Juvenile Center. All restrictions listed below are applicable until such time you receive written notification that you have been released from In-House Detention. VIOLATIONS OF ANY REQUIREMENTS AND/OR RESTRICTIONS MAY RESULT IN DENTENTION IN THE LAKE COUNTY JUVENILE CENTER AND/OR PROSECUTION FOR ESCAPE.

- 1. You are confined to your home and are only allowed to leave for the following purposes:
 - a. Attending school or court approved education program, arriving and departing on time. (You must comply with the Indiana Compulsory School Attendance Law).
 - b. And, when you have been called out by your parent/guardian on the voicemail and then, only if they are with you.
- 2. You may leave your home ONLY in the company of your parents/guardians and ONLY after your parents/guardians have notified the In-House Detention Department ("call out") of your destination by calling the voicemail number which is (219) 881-6341. The first call is to let In-House staff know where you are taking the child and the second call is to let staff know when the child is back in the home. (When the recording comes on, you will be given instructions on what specific information is needed).

- 3. When the juvenile is legitimately too ill to attend school and/or is suspended from attending school, a parent/guardian must leave a voicemail message for In-House staff every morning of each day missed.
- 4. On nights prior to a school day, you must be home by 9pm.
- 5. A working telephone must be maintained in the home. You must allow the In-House Detention staff or Probation to talk to your parent/guardian to verify your location upon request.
- 6. You may be telephoned or visited by the In-House Detention staff at any time.
- 7. You are SOLELY responsible for answering phone calls from the In-House Detention staff. Make sure all family members know how to use "call waiting" to insure that you don't miss a call.
- 8. Meet with the In-House Detention staff or the Probation Officer whenever he/she arrives to check on you.
- 9. Refrain from ALL social activities.
- 10. You are NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, to commit another delinquent act.

Disposition of In-House Detention: SUCCESSFUL UNSUCCESSFUL

- 11. You are to abide by ALL conditions of Probation set by the Court.
- 12. Obey reasonable demands of parents/guardians.
- 13. You are NOT to leave LAKE COUNTY without obtaining permission from the Probation Officer.
- 14. You may not have friends in the home or on the premises <u>until you are given permission to do by the In-</u> House <u>Detention staff.</u>
- 15. <u>Unless there is a verifiable emergency</u>, call outs made other than those within the specified times shall be a violation of In-House Detention.

I have read and understand these requirements and restrictions. I also understand that I need written Court approval to vary any of these restrictions or requirements, including residence.
